## PERENNIALS for SHADE



## AQUILEGIA CAERULEA ‘KIRIGAMI MIX’ (COLUMBINE) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

 Kirigami Mix columbine is a formulated blend of huge, upward facing 2-3 inch, blue, pink, red, rose, white, and yellow flowers. Grows 14-24 inches. Established plants flower over an especially long season, from early spring to early summer. This plant dazzle in mass plantings, mixed borders, cottage gardens, cutting gardens, and containers. Winter hardy perennials to zone 5. Moist, well drained soil. For cut flowers, harvest blooms as they begin to open. Typical vase life is 5 to 7 days. Pinch or cut off spent flowers to extend bloom season. Flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.
## AQUILEGIA CAERULEA ‘ORIGAMI YELLOW’ (COLUMBINE) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

 This is a hybrid strain of Columbine. Plants have a compact habit, the large, up facing blooms usually bicolored in a variety of shades. This particular selection is pale yellow. Flowers are attractive to hummingbirds. Removing spent flowers will increase the blooming time. Great in containers. Since Columbines are relatively short lived, allow some of the plants to go to seed and self sow. Leaf miners or sawfly may disfigure the leaves around flowering time. Simply trim off the ugly foliage and the plants will grow fresh leaves. Zone 3 to 9 , part sun or partial shade, soil moisture average or moist, height: 14-18 inches, spread: 12-18 inches, blooms early summer, late spring, deer \& rabbit resistant.

## ASTILBE ‘PEACH BLOSSOM’ 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

Airy plumes of light peach with a hint of pink move with the slightest breeze. Peach Blossom is the one most tolerant of dry conditions. The lacy and fern-like foliage is vivid green. Works well in a border or in mass planting. Astilbe are mainstays of shade and woodland gardens. Zones 4 8 , height 20 inches, spacing 18 inches, half sun /half shade to full shade, blooms early summer to late summer.


## ASTILBE 'VISION IN WHITE’ 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

'Vision in White' is a robust growing selection which produces loads of large, creamy white, triangular plumes in midsummer. A later blooming species useful for extending the bloom season into late summer. Foliage is deeply incised, coarsely textured, and often bronze-green in color. Though garden performance is far superior in moist soils, members of this species are moderately drought tolerant. Zones 4-9, 28 inches tall and wide, partial to full shade, deer and rabbit resistant, attracts butterflies.

## ATHYRIUM VAR. PICTUM (JAPANESE PAINTED FERN) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH

Also called Japanese Painted Fern, this is one of the most colorful ferns for the garden, the The plant has silvery-grey fronds which are dusty purple towards the center. They are set off by the purplish-red veins and stems. This fern has a low and mounding habit, slowly spreading by rhizomes to form dense colonies. The fronds are positioned in a way that creates a horizontal layering effect much like you see in Dogwood trees. Zones 3-8, height: 12-18 inches, spread: 24 inches, part shade, full shade, rabbit resistant.


BRUNNERA ‘ALEXANDRIA' (SIBERIAN BUGLOSS) 2.5 QT. POT \$19.00 EACH
Alexandria features brilliant mirror-silver leaves with the classic 'Alexander's Great' size and vigor. Tiny clouds of sky-blue flowers in the spring float above the foliage as it emerges. Truly a refreshing garden addition with early flowers for the pollinators. Zones 4-9, blooms April-May, deer resistant.

## BRUNNERA ‘SEA HEART’ (SIBERIAN BUGLOSS) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH

Exquisite green veining throughout the frosted silver leaves resemble the intricate wing of a dragonfly. Sprays of pink buds open to dainty blue flowers for a lovely two-tone effect above the vigorous clump of heart-shaped leaves. An improved variety, the hearty foliage stands up well to heat and humidity. Zones 4-8, height: 6-10 inches, spacing 18 inches, blooms early to late spring.


## HELLEBORUS ‘IVORY PRINCE’ (LENTEN ROSE) 2.5 QT. POT \$19.00 EACH

Outward facing ivory flowers are painted with rose and chartreuse. Early buds are burgundy pink over blue gray foliage. Charming and welcome first flowering perennials of spring. Float flowers in clear bowls for an elegant centerpiece. Zones 4-9, mostly sunny to full shade, height 16 inches, plant 20 inches apart, blooms early to late spring, moist, well-drained soil, low maintenance and very permanent, highly deer, disease and pest resistant and heat, humidity and drought tolerant, good for cut flowers.



## HELLEBORUS STRAIN' HONEYMOON MIX 2.5 QT. POT \$19.00 EACH

Sprinkle your garden with the broad diversity of exquisite colors in this single-flowering Helleborus mix. The plants in this series were selected for their strong garden performance and showy flowers, which range from deepest mahogany to cream with diversely patterned burgundy markings. It has a long flowering season, blooming for five months out of a year. Its foliage is a rich, medium green with leathery, serrated leaves. Zone $4-9$, height 18 to 24 inches and a width of 2 to 3 feet, partial to full shade with moist, well-drained soil, low maintenance and very permanent, highly deer, disease and pest resistant and heat, humidity and drought tolerant, good for cut flowers.


## HEUCHERA ‘SPELLBOUND' (ALUMROOT) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH

Marvelous ruffled foliage of dazzling silvers with tints of rose purple will leave you spellbound. The purple tones are more prominent in the spring and fall. Silver tones are more prevalent in shade. It forms a big plant with a dense, multi-crown habit. Great in containers or in the landscape. A new popularity poll winner! Zones 4-9, Height: 9 inches-16" with flowers, 16 inches wide, Part Shade, Full Sun, bloom time: May, June, July, August, September. Attracts hummingbirds.

## MATTEUCCIA STRUTHIOPTERIS (OSTRICH FERN) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH

Ostrich Fern is a stately, vase-shaped fern that grows between 3-5 feet tall and has a 2 -3 foot spread. It makes for a dramatic addition to a shade garden during the summer months before falling dormant by early fall. This plant is tolerant of a wider variety of soil types, unlike most other ferns, however it is still particular about preferring shade. deer resistant.

## PULMONARIA ‘RASPBERRY FROST’ (LUNGWORT) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH



Coral-red flowers in spring contrast beautifully against a backdrop of silver-blotched foliage edged in creamy white. After flowers fade, leaves continue to emerge from the crown of the plant to provide a fresh, clean look. A great groundcover under small trees and shrubs. Topnotch for the front of a border to brighten a shady niche. Pulmonaria Raspberry Frost will tolerate morning sun but need afternoon shade to avoid leaf scorching. Lungworts are clumpforming perennials spreading over time by rhizomes. It is prized for its wonderfully patterned foliage that remains attractive all season. Zones 4-9, full shade to mostly sunny, height: 10 inches, spacing 18 inches, blooms early to late spring.

## PERENNIALS for SUN

## ALLIUM 'MILLENIUM' (ORNAMENTAL ONION) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

Allium Millenium is one of the very best ornamental onions. Unlike spring-blooming Allium bulbs, this hybrid Allium blooms in mid-summer with large globes of rose-pink flowers. Mature plants have dozens of globes covering this perennial plant. Attractive, shiny deep-green grassy foliage is very ornamental. Zone 5 to 9 , full sun, low water, height 15 inches tall, spread 18-22 inches wide, blooms in summer. Advantages: Attract butterflies, easy to grow, deer resistant, fragrant flower/foliage, good for cut flowers, dried flowers and containers.



ASCLEPIAS INCARNATA 'CINDERELLA' (SWAMP MILKWEED) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH
A genuine star whose unusually dense clusters of pale pink flowers open from dark pink buds. The vanilla-scented flowers last well in water and attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Plants bloom best in full sun but can tolerate a bit of shade. They grow naturally in wet places along streams and ponds. Swamp Milkweed will grow in heavy, wet soil or in good garden soil and are perfect for rain gardens. Of the 200 species in the genus Asclepias, the best known are North American wildflowers. They have small, curiously shaped blooms that appear in dense clusters. These plants provide nourishment for Monarch butterflies through all their life stages and are essential for their survival. Plants are deer resistant and heat tolerant. Zone 3-9, blooms June-August, height 3-5 foot, spacing 24-30 inches.

## ASCLEPIAS TUBEROSA (BUTTERFLY WEED) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

A punch of intense tangerine orange invites droves of butterflies. A butterfly host plant for Monarchs in particular; butterflies also cherish its lavish flower clusters filled with scrumptious nectar. Green seed pods open to glistening silky parachutes that float with the breeze to a new location. Butterfly Weed emerges late in the spring and blooms early to late summer. Requires little care once established. Tough as nails, this beauty is Native to eastern North America. Beneficial for pollinators, butterflies, hummingbirds, deer resistant, good for cut flowers, heat tolerant, Zones 3-9, height: 18-24 inches tall, plant 24 inches apart, full sun.

## COREOPSIS ‘LI’L BANG DAYBREAK' (TICKSEED) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

A very long-blooming perennial, part of the hybrid Li'l Bang ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ series, best suited for sunny areas. It forms a narrow, upright, compact mound of finely-cut, dark green leaves. The exceptionally large, single, red daisy flowers feature a vibrant yellow-orange edge and appear summer to autumn. Well-suited for the front to middle of a sunny border, also good in containers. Excellent disease resistance. Shear mid-season to keep it looking its best all season. Zones 5 to 9, full sun, height 6-10 inches, spread 16-18 inches, attracts butterflies, deer and rabbit resistant, good for cut flowers.


## DELPHINIUM 'GUARDIAN LAVENDER' (LARKSPUR) 2.5 QT. POT \$17.00 EACH

This is a classic perennial part of the Guardian series which were bred for early blooming , vigor and uniformity. This tall light blue lavender spike with uniform blossoms are stunning in a sunny garden. These plants will bloom in early to mid-summer and continue if the growing season is long enough and they have been trimmed back in time to grow again. Plant in the back of the garden and stake if not protected from the wind for best results. 3040 inches tall, Delphinium make an excellent cutting flower and are deer resistant. Bee friendly, attracts butterflies and hummingbirds, deer resistant, Zones 4-8.

## DELPHINIUM ‘NEW MILLENNIUM COBALT DREAMS’ 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

Dark blue flowers with white centers on sturdy stems of densely flowered, multiple spikes. New Millennium hybrids are hardier and more tolerant of heat and humidity than older varieties. Colorful flower spikes rise above lobed leaves. Taller varieties do best with staking. Prune after the spring bloom for rebloom in September. Zones 3-7, full sun, part sun, part shade, height 48 to 60 inches, attracts butterflies, bees, birds, hummingbirds, good for cut flowers.


## DELPHINIUM ‘BLACK KNIGHT’ (LARKSPUR) 1 QT. POT \$10 EACH

Statuesque flowers in rich indigo blue with dark eyes reach skyward on long spires. Elegant and exquisite flower spikes add a majestic touch to your garden. Zones 3-8, full to mostly sun, height 4 to 6 foot, plant 18 to 24 inches apart, blooms early to late summer, attracts butterflies, bees, birds, hummingbirds, good for cut flowers. Taller varieties do best with staking.


## ECHINACEA ‘CHEYENNE SPIRIT’ (CONEFLOWER) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

A delightful mix of brilliant hues of orange, bright red or yellow surround a large brown cone. For strong color impact in your border. *NOTE: Cannot guarantee bloom color (s). Zones 4-9, full sun to mostly sunny, height 2 foot, plant 2 foot apart, blooms mid summer to early fall, attracts pollinators, butterflies, good for cut flower, deer resistant, drought tolerant.

ECHINACEA ‘DOUBLE CODED RASPBERRY BERET’ (CONEFLOWER) 2.5 QT. POT \$19.00 EACH Fully double intense raspberry pink flowers, 4 inch wide, with ray petals to match. Prolific floral production seated atop dense rosettes of foliage. Broad, horizontal ray petals maximize flower size. Zones 4-8, height 18-20 inches, spacing 22-24 inches, blooms mid-late summer, fragrant flower, deer resistant, attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and birds. When the season is over, leave the dried seed heads for the winter birds.


HIBISCUS SYRIACUS ‘STARRY STARRY NIGHT’ TRADE GAL. POT \$19.00 EACH
Incredibly dark, near-black, broad, maple-like leaves form an upright clump in the landscape. Interesting 7-8 inch flowers are pale pink with darker pink speckling and veining. The flowers are held on bright green carpels, which contrast nicely with the dark foliage. Flowers are produced from the top to the bottom of the plant, rather than only at the top like some older cultivars. Zones 4-9, height 3.5-4 foot, blooms mid-summer to early fall, attracts butterflies, bee-friendly, deer resistant.

## LOBELIA CARDINALIS (CARDINAL FLOWER) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

Commonly called cardinal flower this is a clump-forming perennial which features erect, terminal spikes (racemes) of large, cardinal red flowers on unbranched, alternate-leafed stalks rising typically to a height of 2-4 feet. Zone 3 to 9 , full sun to part shade, prefers wetter soil, spreads 1 to 2 feet, blooms July to September, attracts hummingbirds and butterflies,
 rabbit and deer tolerant.

## LONICERA ‘DROPMORE SCARLET’ (HONEYSUCKLE VINE) 2.5 QT. POT \$19.00 EACH

 Masses of showy, tubular flowers burst with color, creating a mini firework display in your garden! Vibrant orange-red flowers bloom in the summer, attracting hummingbirds and butterflies with sweet nectar. As the season changes, flowers give way to small red berries, which are adored by birds. This rugged, semi-evergreen climber couldn't be easier to grow! It quickly grows to cover fences, trellises, railing, mailboxes, and more with blue-green, circular foliage. The best part? This honeysuckle is non-invasive, so you can grow it guilt-free! Zones 4-9, height x width: $15-20$ feet $\mathrm{x} 4-6$ feet, blooms early summer-fall.

## LUPINUS ‘GALLERY YELLOW’ (LUPINE) 1 QT. POT \$10 EACH

Sunshine-yellow spikes, so cheerful and beautiful; Lupines also have the added benefit of being quite deer and rabbit resistant. The tightly packed, sweet pea-shaped blossoms in a breathtaking array of colors invite pollinators to their nectar-rich spires. Zone 4 to 8. Growing 14-16 inches tall, this dwarf variety brings both butterflies and hummingbirds to the landscape. A strong re-seeder. Blooms late spring - mid-summer, full to partial sun.


## MONARDA DIDYMA ‘JACOB CLINE’ (BEEBALM) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

These easy to grow, long blooming plants explode with very large frilly red flowers just as summer begins. Monarda Jacob Cline is considered to be the very best red variety on the market. Hummingbirds love them! A carefree strong grower. These tall plants add vertical accent to the back-of-the border. Their whimsical jester hat shaped blossoms add playful shapes and textures. Zone 4-9, height: 4-5 foot, plant 14-18 inches apart, blooms early summer to early fall, full sun to half sun/half shade. Good for pollinators, attracts butterflies and hummingbirds, deer and rabbit resistant, wet tolerant, good for cut flowers. Easy to grow. Divide spring or fall every 3-4 years. Thinning stems to increase air circulation will help prevent powdery mildew, as will keeping plants watered during dry spells. Foliage can be cut back after flowering to encourage fresh new leaves and possible late fall rebloom.


MONARDA DIDYMA 'PANORAMA MIX'-RED SHADES (BEEBALM) 1 QT. POT \$10.00 EACH Both the flowers and the foliage are fragrant. Panorama mix with its ultra-colorful, frizzy 1 to 2 -inch blooms and its great resistance to powdery mildew. Both the flowers and the foliage boast a spicy, summery scent, and each plant bears up to 20 long stems. Nothing brings in the butterflies, hummingbirds, and bees like Panorama Red Shades Monarda, and these bright flowers bloom profusely in midsummer on vigorous, bushy 3-foot plants. The heavenly fragrance will keep you out in the garden to enjoy all the wildlife, too. Zones 4-9, height 3 foot.

## PAEONIA 'BARTZELLA' (ITOH PEONY) $\mathbf{1}$ GALLON POT \$35.00 EACH

Splash your garden with lots of sweetly fragrant, yellow blooms. Prolific peony produces up to 80 gorgeous double flowers from late spring to early summer. A cross between herbaceous and tree peonies, Itoh peonies have a dense, rounded form, a great abundance of 7-9 inch flowers and a bloom season that lasts up to six weeks. Zones 3-8, height 24-36 inches tall with a similar spread. Deer and rabbit resistant, attracts butterflies, cut flowers. Plant is sturdy and does not require staking.


## PHLOX PANICULATA ‘DAVID’ (GARDEN PHLOX) 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

 Sparkling white giant flowering clusters. Phlox David is very fragrant with light green, mildew resistant foliage. As a staple for the perennial border it mixes well and continues to provide long summer color. When most plants are on their summer siesta, Garden Phlox provide a much needed shot of color. Large blossoms in a range of colors, Garden Phlox are known as the backbone of the perennial border. Zones 4-8, height 2-4 foot, blooms late summer to early fall, cut flowers, pollinator and hummingbird friendly. Deer and rabbits generally avoid phlox.
## ROSE KNOCKOUT DOUBLE PINK 2 GALLON POT \$19.00 EACH

A maintenance-free rose that continually produces self-cleaning bright pink double flowers with a slight spicy fragrance. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot and downy mildew leaf diseases. The rounded, bushy, well-behaved form is excellent for use as a low hedge or accent. Zones 5-9, blooms spring through fall, fast growing; height and width 3 to 4 foot, disease resistant, attracts butterflies and pollinators.


## SEDUM ‘LIZARD’ 1 QT. POT \$10.00 EACH

An exquisite blend of nature's vibrant palette, with foliage that dances between rosy purple and fresh green. A creeping succulent that beautifully weaves itself across gardens, this sedum adorns spaces with delightful summer white blooms that complement its colorful foliage. Stunning purple and pink edged sedum. Easy to care for drought resistant groundcover. Enjoy 7+ weeks of non-fading flowers. Zones 4-9, sun, 8 inches tall $\times 18$ inches wide at maturity. A hardy succulent plant with new growth that emerges pink, white, and purple, maturing to dark purple with hot pink edges in summer sun. Masses of magenta flowers attract butterflies. Great for borders or containers.

## VERONICA ‘PINK CANDLES’ 2.5 QT. POT \$15.50 EACH

These plants have richly pink candlestick blooms that put on a vivid and abundant display that starts in early summer. They are an excellent choice for borders, rock gardens, mass plantings, and beds. These little beauties grow to around 1 foot tall x 1 foot wide, and provide an excellent color and texture combination. Zones 4-8, 8 inches high and 10 inches wide, long bloom time, disease resistant, containers, cut flowers, deer and rabbit resistant, attracts pollinators.


## VEGETABLES

## SUN KING BROCCOLI 4 PACK \$5.00

Attractive blue-green heads sit ready to harvest through the heat and sweeten more when kissed by fall frosts. Well leafed plants yield these 6-8" diameter heads and 5-10 1" side shoots as well. Avoid planting in garden area where cabbage family was grown the year before. Withstands light frost.


## BOK CHOY 4 PACK \$5.00

Bok Choy, also called white Chinese cabbage, belongs to the leafy vegetable pak choi family of Chinese brassicas. Bok Choy has white or green, thick, crunchy stems with light to dark green wide leaves. Size can vary from 4-12 inches tall! All parts, stems and leaves, are eaten.

## MARKETMORE 76 SLICING CUCUMBER 2.5" POT \$4.00 OR 2] FOR \$7/.00



Marketmore 76 is a very popular variety in the home garden. It is 8 to 9 inches long at maturity, dark green and is resistant to many cucumber diseases. It is an excellent slicer in salads and for other fresh uses. Approx. 66 days to maturity.


## EGGPLANT CLASSIC 4" POT \$5.00

Here is the Eggplant of your parmigiana dreams! With glossy, 8-9 inch long, teardrop-shaped fruit, this versatile heavy fruiter will give you the taste and tenderness that will keep you coming back for more. For bigger fruits, restrict to five or six per plant, pinching off the extra flowers that develop. Eggplant grows best in a well-drained sandy loam or loam soil that is fairly high in organic matter.

## ARUGULA 6 PACK \$5.00

Arugula is grown similar to lettuce and is a good source of vitamins A and C, which are important for eye health and your immune system. Arugula also contains antioxidants and phytonutrients which keep you healthy.


## ALLSTAR GOURMET LETTUCE MIX 6 PACK $\$ 5.00$

A specially designed blend based on two years of trial research to make your salad mix stand out from the crowd. Selected varieties yield darker reds and greens even under low-light conditions. ## LETTUCE, BUTTERCRUNCH 6 PACK \$5.00

## ROMAINE (PARIS ISLAND COS) (HEIRLOOM) 6 PACK \$5.00

This variety boasts all the merits of a commercially bred variety, but the crisp and sweetly scrumptious leaves say heirloom. Super uniform, upright leaves, observed disease tolerance, and moderate bolt resistance. Fuchsias love lots of filtered light but are particularly intolerant of heat. Slow-release fertilizers are ideal for use in outdoor beds, while hanging baskets and containers will prefer liquid feeds. Starting in the spring, balanced fertilizers can be applied once every two weeks throughout periods of active growth. Fuchsias will thrive and blossom more abundantly if they're pinched back as new growth appears.

## Lantana

Do-it-all, plant heat-loving favorite produces steady stream of flower clusters from spring into fall. A mantle of clustered blooms soon covers vigorous mounding annual with fragrant foliage. Choice cultivar with trailing growth is a natural for group plantings: excelling as a groundcover, beguiling in the border, or joyfully cascading. Lantana is a magnet for butterflies and hummingbirds. Hardy, low-upkeep plants are heat-tolerant, drought-resistant, and deer- resistant. Be sure to prune back after first flowering to encourage additional bud growth.
